Extitudo Política Abierta is a Global organization in Bogota Columbia working with a multi-party think-do-thank that works for innovation and more accessible politics) continues with its objective of *strengthening the capacities of organizations, communities, and democracy professionals to enhance youth participation in governance through deliberative practices.*

In 2021 Extitudo Política Abierta received support from NED and People Powered, along side others to implement Demo.Reset in 6 Global south regions(Brazil, Kenya, Latin America, Mexico, India and Africa)

➤ ***Before we begin: Reflecting on the journey so far***

DEMO.REST 1.0 was the first phase implementation of the project which activated and nurtured relationships focused on mutual learning, collective intelligence, and capacity building for deliberation and citizen engagement. - Back in October 2022, we brought together 35 organizations from the Global South in Bogota, Colombia for [DemoReset/Lab](#) where we crafted 6 game-changing prototypes aimed at tackling the challenges we've identified. Four (4) of those prototypes received major upgrades, and had the opportunity to initiate. Residency team was selected to to implementation with host organization in target country within the democratic residences of DemoReset. The residence were developed this year 2023 in alliance with People Powered, 6 prototypes and projects were tested in total. Jane & Guy was privileged to attend residency in Kenya to test effect ways of youth expression and participation in governace while factor solutions towards addressing challenges they face.



DEMO.REST 2.0 is the second phase implementation of the project which gears towards consolidating efforts and achievement of Demo Rest 1.0 by mobilizing new members from community of practice to understand different deliberative practices, expand Demo Rest networks in Sub-Sahara Africa while research and create awareness on Demo Rest that enable general public to join Deliberative HUB node.

ABOUT THE CALL TO DELIBERATIVE PRACTICE

Identify, Strengthen, and Test deliberation practices in the different communities and organizations that are part of the Demo Reset project located in the four(4)Action Hubs:

- ***Sub-Saharan Africa, Southeast Asia and India, Eastern Europe, and Latin America.***

INCENTIVES AND SUPPORT

1. Technical support , methodological and Mentoring

Mentoring by Experts to enhance deliberation practices. Mapping the deliberative route characterizing the fundamental aspects of calls, pedagogy, communication, methodological design, deliberation, decision-making, and sustainability.

2. Pedagogical Materials, Guides and Repositories

Step-by-step methodological guides for the organization to plan and execute communications strategies and advocacy paths. Creation of a repository of the practice that will allow the organization or alliance to use it as a brochure to present to potential funders.

3. Adaptation Improvements and Test Design

Adaptation and improvement of aspects identified in mapping the deliberative route. Design a regional laboratory proposal to test the adaptations. Organizations and regional lab proposals not selected for funding transfer will be allowed to present their proposals to our partners in the advisory committee.

4. Transfer of 10,000 (USD) to the selected organization and laboratory proposal. These funds must be used for the implementation of the regional on-site laboratory. These funds may only be used to cover the following costs:

- *Contractual Services related to the laboratory:* mentors, editor, translator, and assists
- *Other Direct Costs of the implementation of the laboratory:* Supplies & Materials and Space Rental Labs
- *Costs associated with local travel and per diem* for out-of-town attendees to the regional laboratory will be analyzed by Extituto and partially covered with Demo.Reset project resources, according to the specific need in each Hub.
- *Extituto will provide methodological and logistical support* for the laboratory implementation.
- ***Extituto will provide support in the process of collecting lessons learned*** and evaluating the laboratory.
